Dear Judge Jacobs,

I hope this message finds you well. My name is [REDACTED] and I am writing to formally oppose the name change petition submitted by Christian Walden.

Since 2023, I, along with many others, have been adversely affected by Mr. Walden's so-called "investment firm." He has falsely represented himself as an investor, promoting daily returns of 2-3% profits, which have led to considerable financial losses for myself and others involved. His deceptive practices have raised serious concerns and have triggered a federal investigation into his operations, which appear to target individuals nationwide. Furthermore, it is important to note that Mr. Walden is currently under probation.
